Family Information

- Please fill in all family information including Mother's Maiden Name. This information is needed to properly record all future sacraments.
- **NEW FAMILIES**: please contact the Parish Office at 630-469-0404 to register your family with the parish.
- The RE office may periodically use photos of RE students on the RE website, parish bulletin, RE Facebook page or in the weekly RE newsletter. Please be sure to indicate in the designated field if you do not want our office to use images of your child.

Student Information

- Please fill out each student's information completely. All information requested is important, particularly for permanent sacrament information required by the Diocese of Joliet.
- NEW STUDENTS: please provide all previous Sacrament information, including a copy of their <u>baptismal certificate</u>.
- Children in Grades 3-8 who have not received the sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation, or First Holy Communion are always welcome in our program and will be assessed to determine an appropriate Individual Sacrament Plan, which may take place outside of regular RE classes and may incur a different tuition fee.

Volunteer Information

- Our program needs about **45+ adult volunteers each week** to run smoothly, including Catechists, Catechist Assistants, and Substitute Catechists. It truly takes a village, and we are very grateful to anyone willing to help!

TUITION AND FEES WORKSHEET – ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS

Tuition

- A \$25 tuition discount is offered for families that register prior to **July 15, 2024**. Early registration helps us plan our year and recruit catechists. Thank you!
- Note that no new Sacraments will be given, or registrations processed if your family has an outstanding balance.

Bibles

Our students receive their own bible in Grade 4 - the cost is \$20 per bible and is included on the fees form.

Sacrament Fees:

 Two years of sacramental preparation are required for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation (typically in December of Grade 2), First Holy Communion (typically in April of Grade 2), and Confirmation (typically in March of Grade 8).
 Separate registration forms will be mailed to your family in preparation for these Sacraments.

Financial Aid

- Please do not delay your registration due to financial difficulty. The Faith Fund, established by the RE Board, provides the option to reduce or waive tuition for those who can demonstrate the need for tuition assistance.
- In your generosity, please consider providing a donation to the Faith Fund. 100% of your donation will fund tuition for families in need, at the discretion of the Director of RE or Pastor.
