A visually impaired woman in her 60's, was moving to subsidized housing close to her son. Because of moving costs, she asked for one month's rent to help get her started in the new place. A St. Petronille SVDP volunteer helped her get a new mattress and box spring. The volunteer contacted the DuPage Center for Independent Living who assisted her with resources for independent functioning, including a computer complete with a special program for the visually impaired. This is just one example of the way SVDP makes a difference.

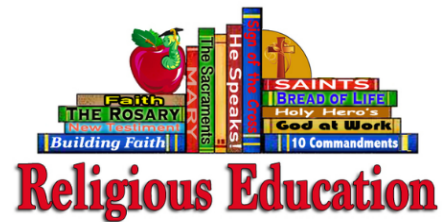

## CHOOSE LIFE MINISTRY

### A St. Petronille Missionary Couple Shares a LIFE Story

Last Christmas we received a card from a local pregnancy support clinic with a check for \$500.00 as a thank you for our volunteer work of interpreting ultrasounds. We called and told them no gift was expected and to please use the funds for those in need coming to the clinic. They insisted, stating this was not from their revenue and that they wanted to show their appreciation, but we knew that we'd have to find a way to pay it forward.

A few weeks later while in the Philippines we heard of the Oikos Sisters' dream of a future ministry, a pregnancy support desk/station in the new Community Center, for women with crisis pregnancies, unwed mothers, mothers living in extreme poverty, incest and rape victims, etc. In the Philippines, birth control is not commonly encouraged and abortion is illegal. Despite this, we hear both are being done at times. In fact, at the hospital where we work, Salcedo Hospital, about 18 months ago an infant girl was brought to the hospital who was found in the weeds with her placenta still attached. This small, local hospital brought her to a higher care hospital where she survived. The medical director of this small hospital where we work became a foster mother to the little girl and named her Destiny. She is a delightful little child and brings joy to many. She is in the process of being adopted by the foster mother/medical director.

During our most recent visit, we discovered that Destiny's natural mother, age 17, is pregnant again and is contemplating an abortion. Needless to say, she is receiving support and counseling along with many prayers.

So we have found a home for the \$500.00—seed money to help establish a pregnancy support desk/station at the Community Center in Oikos Village where women in need of prenatal care and help with delivery will be referred to the Salcedo Hospital for continued care.

Surely the Holy Spirit is guiding us all, every step of the way...

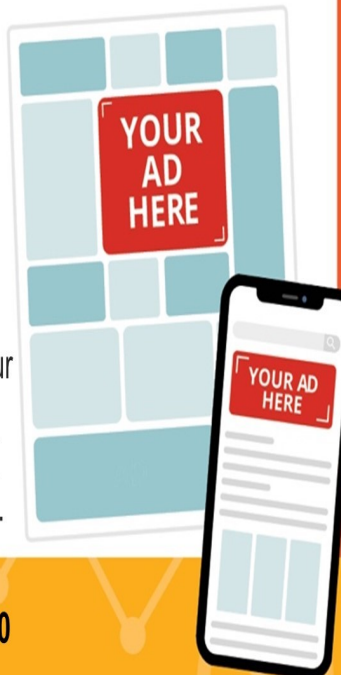

## Eucharistic Adoration Every Friday

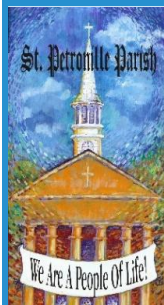


We have the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the Church every Friday from 3-10pm, 24-hour Adoration on First Fridays following the 8am Mass
